

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY CURRICULUM

The Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology (MSLP) at St. Ambrose University is a 2-year program. Year One is spent on campus in Davenport, Iowa, and Year Two can be completed in a flexible location.

MSLP graduates complete a total of 60 credits. This includes one year of clinical experience and coursework, two full-time internships (child and adult), one graduate research project, one service learning presentation on the intersection of speech-language pathology and social justice, and one evidence-based capstone paper.
