

MASTER OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY ADMISSION APPEAL PROCESSES

Applicants to the SAU MSLP Program who have been denied acceptance into the program may appeal the decision to the program director. Applicants have two weeks from the decision date to inform the program director of his/her plan to appeal the admission decision.

The program director and applicant will arrange a time to meet face-to-face or via the phone to discuss the admission decision. The applicant will have two weeks following that conversation to submit a letter and any supporting documentation to support reasons why the denial should be overturned. That information will be received by the program director and delivered to the program's Admission Appeals Committee.

The Committee will have two weeks to consider the appeal. The applicant will immediately be informed of the Committee's decision via phone and a formal letter.
